- three proprietary AI systems: LinkLeges® for the recognition and verification of legislative and case law references; ShieldLeges® for anonymization and privacy protection; ScanLeges® for advanced OCR of typewritten and handwritten documents and automatic audio transcription (speech-to-text);
- users' Practice Files and Contact Records, which transform documents, legal filings and emails into a personal knowledge base that can be queried by the AI agent alongside official legal sources.

Thanks to the collaboration with Gruppo Simone, **OpenLeges will host a dedicated subscription section, enabling users to combine the platform's capabilities with the legal heritage of *Il Foro Italiano***, consisting of more than one million documents, case notes and headnotes to support legal research, analysis and the practical application of the law. All content will be made available in full compliance with copyright legislation.
